

COSY CAMPING CAMPFIRE



Why not build a cosy campfire to have in your indoor camp? Find the instructions below. You don't need to get anything extra; you can just use things you will have around the house. If you don't have something on our list of things you will need, alternatives can be used! If you don't have many tubes or much newspaper then you can still make your campfire too!

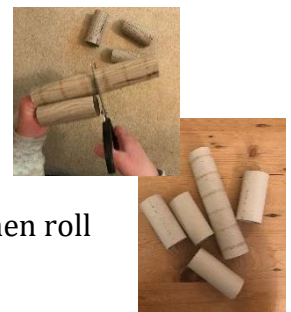


YOU WILL NEED:

- ▽ Toilet roll/ kitchen roll centres OR old newspaper/ magazines.
- ▽ Yellow, red and orange paper OR white paper which can be coloured OR red, yellow and orange fabric.
- ▽ Brown or black pen
- ▽ Sellotape (not essential)
- ▽ Pebbles or rocks (optional)
- ▽ Cotton wool (optional)

METHOD:

1. Get your toilet roll centers or kitchen roll centers. If needed, cut your kitchen roll centers in half. If you are using newspapers or magazines then roll it up.



2. Draw lines on your rolls to look like bark on a log. You could draw lines on your newspaper or magazine or twist them so they look like logs.

3. Stack your rolls in a circle in a teepee shape. You may need to use sellotape to join your rolls together at the top or use an extra set of hands to hold the rolls in place as you add the others. Don't worry if your rolls collapse a whilst you are doing this. I had to try several times to stack mine!



4. Add red, yellow and orange flame shapes to the top of your 'logs' to 'light' your fire. If you are using tissue paper then you may not need to cut our shapes. You may need to tape your 'flames' into place in your rolls.
5. You could add extra decoration to your fire if you want to be adding a ring of pebbles or stones around the edge of your 'fire' or add cotton wool to the top to add 'smoke'.
